The Global Fund provides a strong return on investment

\$2 to \$1 match

Every \$1 paid by United States taxpayers is **matched** by \$2 from international donors

\$31:1 economic returns

\$31 in **economic returns** and health gains for every dollar invested

26% increase in life expectancy

26% **increase** in life expectancy, from 52 years to 66 years, in 15 sub-Saharan African countries since 2002

\$85 billion savings

Global Fund investments have **freed up** resources and capacities, helping countries to better respond to other diseases. For example, as of the end of 2023, investments in HIV have freed up 1.7 billion HIV-related hospitalization days and averted 1.4 billion outpatient visits, generating \$85 billion in cost savings

Ending malaria **will boost economies**, including in the U.S.

+\$126.9 billion

additional GDP of countries in Africa if malaria cases are cut by 90%

+\$31 billion

in additional exports to some of the most affected malaria endemic countries in Africa and almost \$1.5 billion for the United States, if malaria cases are cut by 90%

U.S. leadership inspires other donor countries to step up investments

30% increase

in pledges from other long-term donors, including Canada, the European Commission, Germany and Japan

Advances U.S. diplomatic and security interests and keeps Americans safe

The Global Fund has invested \$15 billion [in challenging operating environments](#) like Ukraine, which is experiencing the impact of war and mass displacement. U.S. investments in health can promote stability, mitigate extremism and avoid costly longer-term military interventions.

In areas where the Global Fund works to end epidemics, there have been tangible [improvements](#) in political freedom, control of corruption, governmental accountability and the rule of law, an analysis from Georgetown University showed.

In each country receiving grants, local experts guide programming through Global Fund [Country Coordinating Mechanisms](#). These organizations also help build [participatory governance](#) in countries that often have few democratic institutions.

Polling from the Reagan Institute shows that a bipartisan majority of Americans think [U.S. global leadership](#) is beneficial to both the United States and the world.

The Global Fund [evaluates and monitors](#) activities before, during and after a grant has been implemented to ensure the proper use of grant funds and verify results and data.

The Global Fund requires countries that receive grants to [increase domestic financing](#) for health.

The Global Fund [works closely](#) with countries to help them achieve long-term sustainability of health programs, so they can maintain progress and continue to expand services after Global Fund support ends.

The Global Fund scales access to new private sector tools and supports innovation

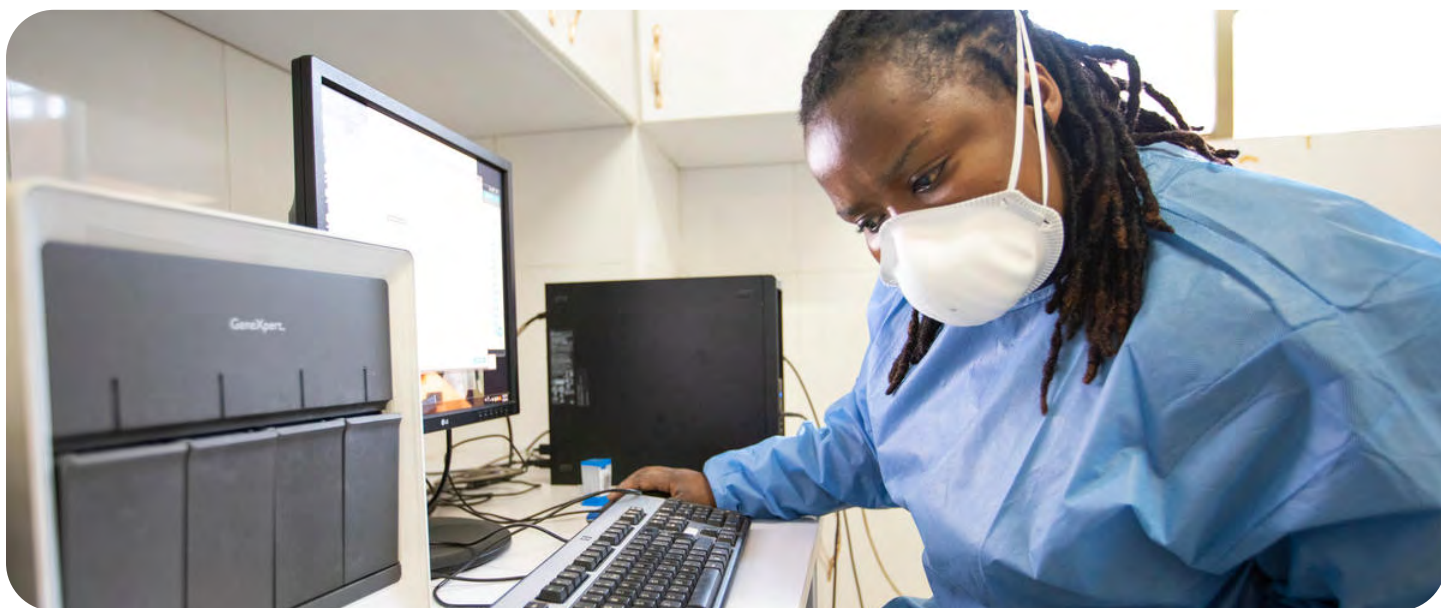
The Global Fund's Innovative [Pooled Procurement Mechanism](#) provides access to competitive market terms and prices no matter the size or value of the order.
